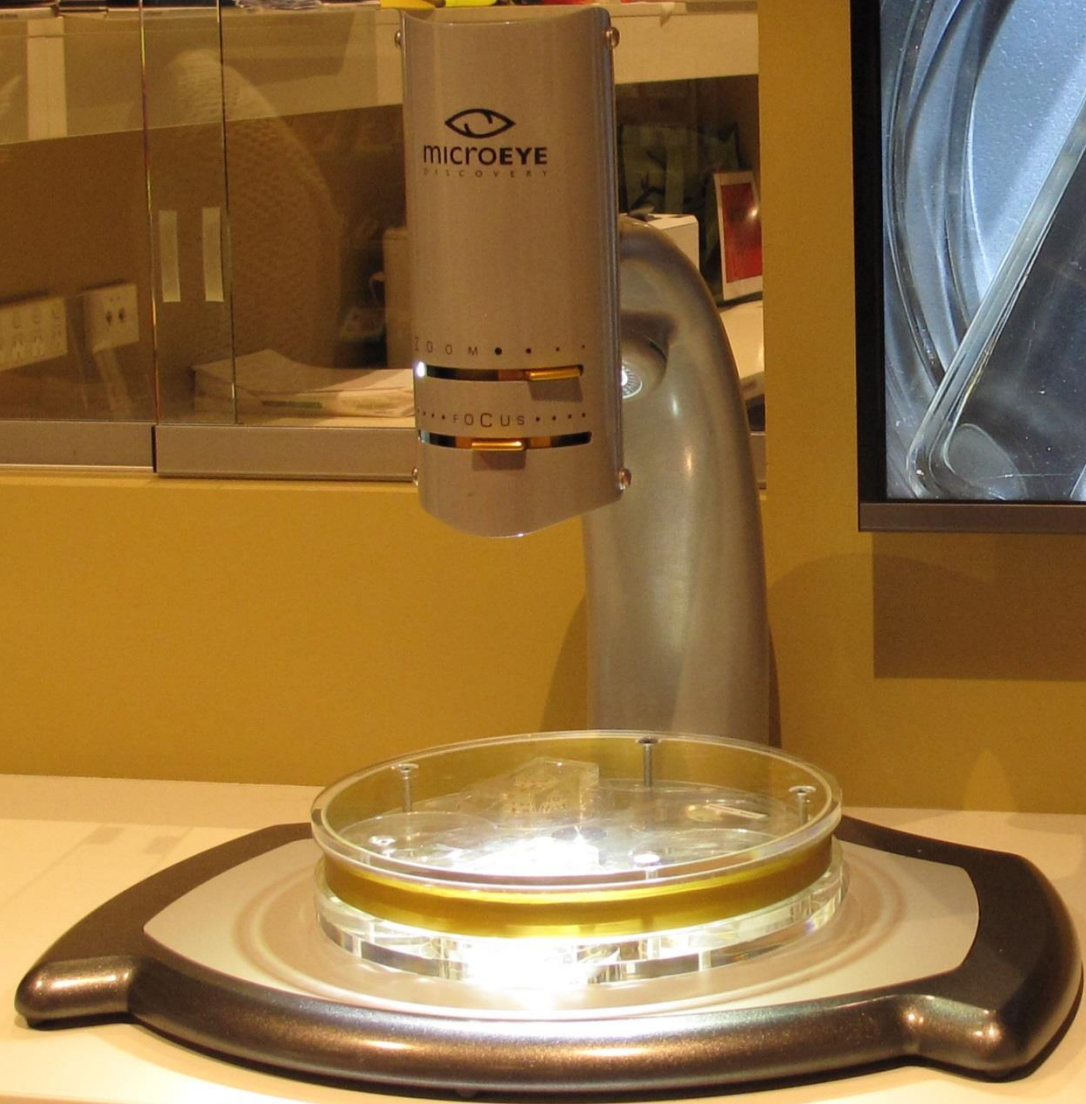

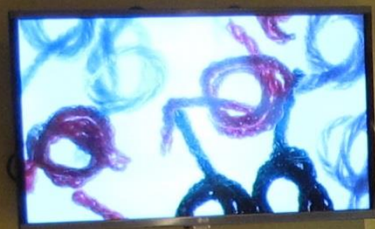

Lamp Shark Skull



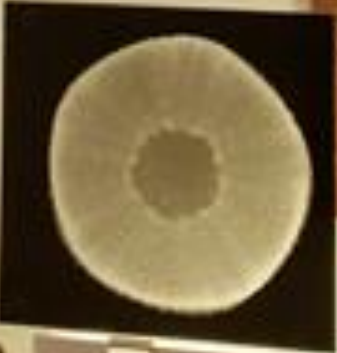

A traditional instrument made from an African fruit which has been carved and burnt by hand, then filled with small stones.



Lamellaphone
A is a type of percussion instrument unique to Africa. They are made from strips of metal or bamboo which is then mounted on a board, box or gourd. Also known as a *mbira*, *kalimba*, or *likembe* in different parts of Africa



Shuka
This blanket worn traditionally by the Maasi people. It is worn to represent the red dirt in that part of Africa as a sort of camouflage.

Sextant
The sextants were created around 1730 provided mariners with a more accurate means of determining the angle between the horizon and the Sun, moon, or stars in order to calculate latitude and longitude observations used in navigation.
